
Drama Club Play

Description of field trip: Wild Reptile Adventure generally travels to schools, birthday parties, and other events with a variety of reptiles for a hands on educational experience. Name of field trip: Saluda Shoals Ropes Course

Address of event: Saluda Shoals Park (5605 Bush River Road, Columbia, 29212)

Description of field trip: The Real Team Challenge Course is a low ropes program at Saluda Shoals Park offering a series of physical and mental challenges designed to improve the performance and cohesiveness of a group. This low ropes course is a series of cables, ropes and wooden beams placed among the trees form the elements of a low ropes course. The elements are built close to the ground so the perceived risk is low, but still challenging to complete.

Participants walk tight-ropes, negotiate obstacles, balance elements as a team, pass teammates through a giant web and climb walls. During each element, teams explore risk taking, problem-solving, leadership skills and effective communication and with a strong focus on collaboration.

**Parking at Saluda Shoals is included for non-members of the park. More information will be given later regarding where to meet on the day of the program.
